**Spiritual Adoption—Third Month**  
*"I Grabbed My Hands"*

Your baby can now squint, swallow and move his/her tongue. He or she sleeps and awakens. Their fingernails and toenails are formed and they now have their own unique set of finger prints, sensitive to touch. He or she will lightly grasp an object placed in their hand. Amniotic fluid is breathed in to help develop and strengthen the respiratory system as the oxygen comes through the umbilical cord. Your baby is now three inches long.

## SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH

**Baptized** parishioners between the ages of **16** (on or before May 31, 2011) **and not yet 18 who are still in high school** are invited to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Classes run September to April/May of the following year most Sundays, 9:40-10:40AM.

**Candidates** are required: to provide proof of Baptism; to attend class; to participate in class service project, parish Life Teen, retreat, and a day of reflection with sponsors.

**Sponsors** are required: to provide a statement of eligibility & proof of reception of sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, & Holy Eucharist); participation in a day of reflection.
