SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH

### Japan Earthquake & Tsunami Response

Thank you for your generous support for the people of Japan during this time of need. Donations to the Japan emergency relief efforts are being sent to Catholic Relief Services who is supporting Caritas Japan (the Catholic church's social outreach agency) and other partners to provide aid to those in need. In addition to these relief efforts, CRS continues to serve people suffering from poverty, hunger and disease in more than 100 countries. And so we also are grateful for your support of the regular CRS Lenten Collection on the weekend of April 2-3, which provides an important source of funding for 6 Catholic organizations addressing the needs of the poor worldwide. ### Saint Vince de Paul News



SVDP receives grants from Federal, State and Private funds.

Our grant from the State is for Emergency Shelter. We use this grant to put Families in a motel for 1 day to 2 weeks at a time, depending upon the situation and how much money we have. It was \$2700 matching grant last year. SVDP matched it. This gave us revenue to provide shelter for 31 families.

Due to procedure changes that may require us to give names and personal information of those we assist into a data base, that may be available to other agencies, we will NOT apply for the State grant.

The Federal grant has been for utilities, rent & mortgage. It was in the amount of \$4303. One of the families we assisted was able to keep their home from foreclosure. We, at this time, do not know what the NEW requirements will be for the Federal grant.

SVDP has a confidentiality policy, of which, we are NOT willing to waiver. Please pray that we are able to make wise decisions and respect the dignity of those we serve. God will provide the finances we need to serve HIS people.
