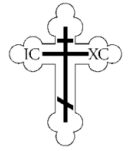

## SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH

**Baptized** parishioners between the ages of **16** (on or before May 31, 2011) **and not yet 18 who are still in high school** are invited to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Classes run September to April/May of the following year most Sundays, 9:40-10:40AM.

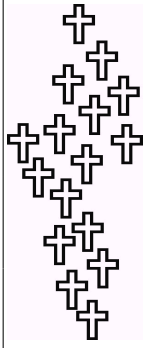

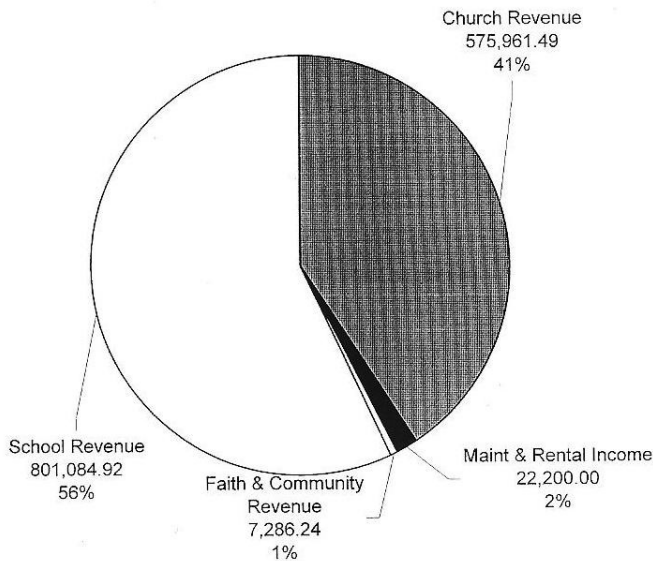

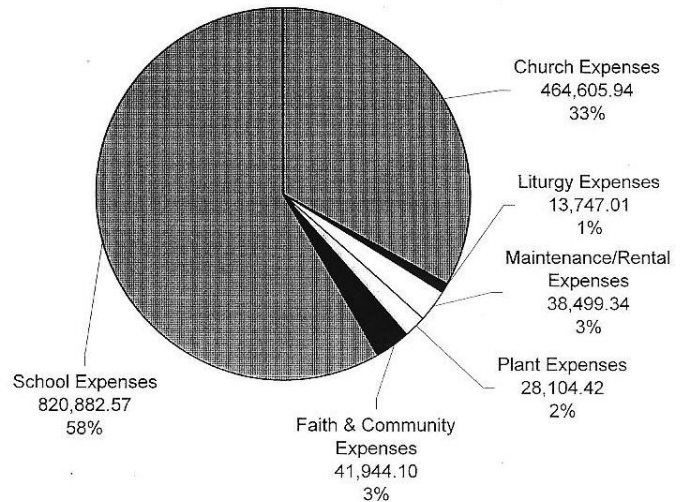

Total Parish income is \$605,448 and expenses are \$586,900. Total combined income of \$1,406,533 and expenses of \$1,407,783 include non-cash depreciation expense of \$94,552. We also spent \$21,941 in general restricted funds and \$40,281 in restricted capital improvement funds during the fiscal year (July 1, 2009—June 30, 2010). At fiscal year end our assets totaled \$3.3 million and our liabilities were \$220,000. # 2010 Annual Report from the Faith in Action Team (FIAT)

The Faith in Action Team (FIAT) meets monthly to study and promote Catholic social teaching. This year FIAT has been studying Pope Benedict's first social encyclical, *Caritas in Veritate*, using a reflection guide published by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). The encyclical addresses many contemporary social issues.

In addition to monthly studies and discussions, FIAT disburses .025 of our parish's monthly collections as "parish alms" to organizations whose works of mercy are congruent with the Church's moral and social teachings. Since the Church is universal, FIAT exercises the moral virtue of solidarity on behalf of our parish by supporting local, national and international groups.

FIAT has recently identified the small mission of Mazo Cruz, in the altiplano region of Peru, as a primary international focus. Located about 14,000 feet above sea level in the Andes Mountains, the climate is harsh and the people are poor. Though it has a church and rectory, current funds only allow intermittent visits by a priest and catechist who must travel a great distance.

In September three FIAT members (Rodger Hardin, Dan O'Rourke and Janet Lawler) journeyed to Peru and visited Mazo Cruz. They provided \$1,000 to purchase a motorcycle for the mission, because the catechist spent countless hours on his bicycle serving remote souls (his farthest destination a four-hour trek). While staying at the Daughters of Charity orphanage in Puno, they worked with the poor, distributed the generous gifts donated by Queen of Angels parishioners, and learned about services provided by the Mary Bloom Center.

The trip was transformative for those who went and allowed the rest of the FIAT group to feel we have made a significant contribution to our Faith on behalf of Queen of Angels. FIAT looks forward to our continued relationship with the people of the Mazo Cruz and the altiplano region and hopes for future visits and exchanges.

Parish alms provided by Queen of Angels also supported Totus Tuus (hospice for abandoned terminally ill children), Edmundite Missions (relief to poor in America's Deep South) as well as prison ministries, homeless ministries, monasteries, crisis pregnancy assistance and more. The recipients of our parish's charity are truly grateful, and members of FIAT are honored by the service we provide. We invite everyone to visit our bulletin board in the parish hall for postings about FIAT activities and work.

FIAT members this year included: Deacon Peter Flatley, Dan O'Rourke (Chair), Rodger Hardin, Beverley Belgau, Nancy Hierwarter, Janet Lawler, Bud Lund and Penney Thiemann.
