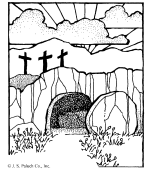

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH

Baptized parishioners between the ages of **16** (on or before May 31, 2011) **and not yet 18 who are still in high school** are invited to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Classes run September to April/May of the following year most Sundays, 9:40-10:40AM.

Candidates are required: to provide proof of Baptism; to attend class; to participate in class service project, parish Life Teen, retreat, and a day of reflection with sponsors.

Sponsors are required: to provide a statement of eligibility & proof of reception of sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, & Holy Eucharist); participation in a day of reflection.

Child Abuse Prevention Month

When the stone is rolled away on Easter morning, the hope and joy of the miracle of the Resurrection is revealed!

In 2009 there were approximately 800,000 cases of child maltreatment (abuse & neglect), according to the US Department of Health & Human Services. These victims often experience devastating and lifelong effects of abuse. Their miracle comes when the abuse stops and the healing can begin. Their hope lies in you when you report suspected abuse to the proper authorities.

If you suspect that a child or vulnerable adult is being (or has been) abused, call the proper law enforcement agency or the DSHS hotline at : 1-866-END-HARM. Reports should be made within 48 hours of discovering the abuse.
