## SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH

**Baptized** parishioners between the ages of **16** (on or before May 31, 2011) **and not yet 18 who are still in high school** are invited to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Classes run September to April/May of the following year most Sundays, 9:40-10:40AM.

### Japan Earthquake & Tsunami Response

Archbishop Sartain writes, "As you know, our sisters and brothers in Japan have suffered terribly in recent days because of the earthquake and tsunami. The Catholics of Western Washington join the international community in expressing our heartfelt compassion for all affected, and through the important work of Catholic Relief Services we plan to offer our financial assistance.

The annual collection for Catholic Relief Services is the weekend of April 2-3. Please support this effort, which provides badly needed assistance for catastrophic events as well as ongoing challenges of poverty and disease around the world. In lieu of a special or second collection for aid to Japan, 30% of the regular collection received in the Archdiocese this year will be designated for Japan relief. ### Saint Vincent de Paul News



SVDP receives grants from Federal, State and Private funds.

Our grant from the State is for Emergency Shelter. We use this grant to put Families in a motel for 1 day to 2 weeks at a time, depending upon the situation and how much money we have. It was \$2700 matching grant last year. SVDP matched it. This gave us revenue to provide shelter for 31 families.

Due to procedure changes that may require us to give names and personal information of those we assist into a data base, that may be available to other agencies, we will NOT apply for the State grant.

The Federal grant has been for utilities, rent & mortgage. It was in the amount of \$4303. One of the families we assisted was able to keep their home from foreclosure. We, at this time, do not know what the NEW requirements will be for the Federal grant.

SVDP has a confidentiality policy, of which, we are NOT willing to waiver. Please pray that we are able to make wise decisions and respect the dignity of those we serve. God will provide the finances we need to serve HIS people.
