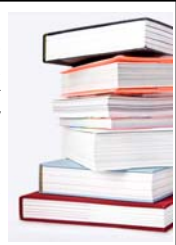

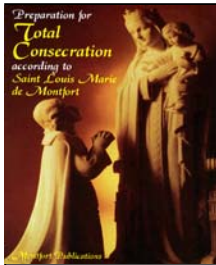
### CHURCH CLEANING
