Meet on Tuesday, April 6, in the St. Anne Room from 1-3 PM. All women in the parish are encouraged to attend.

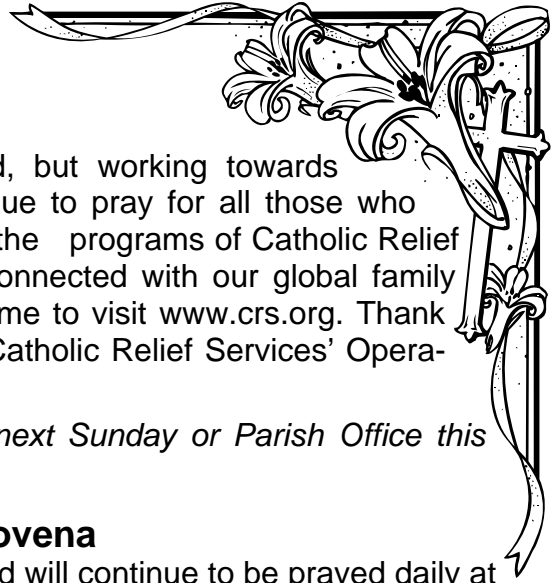

Please bring your Rice Bowl Alms to church next Sunday or Parish Office this week.

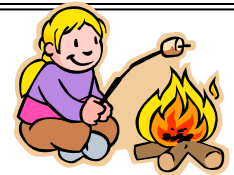


Divine Mercy Novena

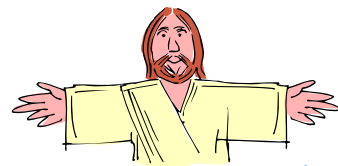
