St. Martin de Porres Guild

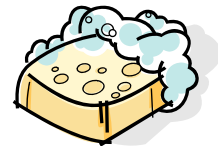

Our next coffee hour will be June 27.

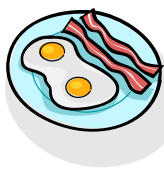


Lay Carmelites

PRAYER BREAKFAST

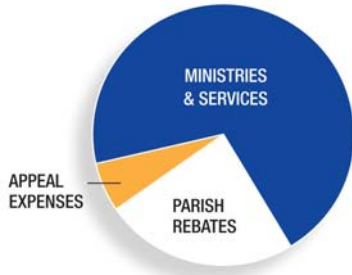
