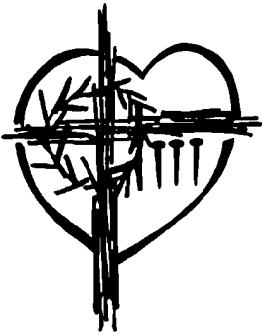


## **KEEPING THE SPIRIT OF LENT**
